Tulane has opened the season on a Thursday night seven of the last eight years. The Green Wave has won all seven meetings with the last coming in '14. The Lions went 8-5 LY & lost at Ole Miss 40-29.

TU has lost 12 of their L/15 road openers, incl 7 straight, however 4 were by 7 pts or less. Green Wave lost only prior meeting 41-39 in '13. Tulane is 10-6 SU/11-7 ATS under HC Willie Fritz.

Green Wave were looking to avoid their fifth straight loss to Navy when TU hosted the Middies on senior day in '18. Tulane led 21-3 at HT but Navy came back in the 2H but were able to hold off Navy, 29-28.

Rematch of last year's Armed Forces Bowl won by Tulane 30-13. SM was missing QB Abraham for that game. LTH in '09 SM led 20-0 at half and romed Tulane 43-6.

Bonus: HC Fritz is 8-2 in his career of a bye (4-2 here).

Bonus: LY Tulane was 5-0 as a home favorite.

LTH ('18) on a Thurs, Tulane was off an HC win & travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks for their road finale. Houston all'd an FBS ssn low 359 tt yds as the Green Wave lost for the only time in their L/5 gms.

Last win against SMU was here in '12 but the Green Wave have lost five straight to their AAC West rivals 1-4 ATS. TU was a td home fav in '18 & held SMU to only 36 rush yds (1.1) but were upset 27-23.

LTH ('16) Tulane was travelling for the second time in three weeks. The Green Wave trailed 7-6 at the half, but was outscored 30-0 in the 2H. Tulane was +51 yds, but was -3 TO's.

Tulane's last win against the Owls came back in 1935! As AAC foes the Green Wave have lost four straight SU & ATS. Tulane was outgained 533-142 here in '16 and were shutout by Temple 31-0 (+14).

LTH ('17) Tulane had lost four straight but were a 5.5 point road favorite against the Pirates. EC would tie the gm on a 9 yd td pass with :36 left to send the gm to OT but Tulane would win 31-24.

Green Wave lead the all-time series 12-9-1 incl 3 straight wins. Home team has won just 2 of last 7. LY Tulane scored 21 straight to take a 42-21 lead w/5:46 left, before 2 late Army td's.

LTH ('18) Tulane entered having lost four of their last five games. The Green Wave trailed by 10 in the middle of the third quarter, but scored the go-ahead td on a 39 yard run with 3:46 left.

The Green Wave have lost 3 of their L/5 on senior day at Yulman Stadium. Tulane hosted the Tigers in their '18 AAC opener. TU had a 496-277 yard edge and upset Memphis 40-24 (+14).
