Sep. 26	at Arkansas St	A					LTH ('17) was the ssn opener on a Thurs. OSU entered #10 AP and led 38-17 at the half with a 453-157 yard edge! Tulsa has lost 22 of their last 25 road openers & hasn't beaten a P5 foe since 2010.		
Oct. 3	at UCF	G					LTH ('02) Tulsa was off a blowout loss vs #1 AP Oklahoma and playing in their road opener. The Golden Hurricane last travelled to an SBC member in 2008 when they beat North Texas 56-26.		
Oct. 10							LTH ('16) Tulsa was on the 2nd of B2B away games and playing their road finale. The Golden Hurricane had a ssn low 126 pass yds, but still finished with a 153 yard edge.		
Oct. 17	<small>CINCINNATI IS OFF BYE</small> Cincinnati (HC)	A					Bonus: Tulsa hasn't beaten a ranked foe since 2010 and hasn't beaten a ranked foe at home since 2004. Bonus: The Golden Hurricane were 5-2 ATS LY as an underdog.		
Oct. 23	at USF <small>(Fri)</small>	G					Tulsa has lost 6 of the L/7 meetings against the Bearcats. Tulsa entered at 8-3 in '16 and were a big 22.5 point home fav. The game would go to OT where Tulsa would win on a fg, 40-37.		
Oct. 30	<small>EAST CAROLINA IS OFF BYE</small> East Carolina <small>(Fri)</small>	A					LTH ('18) the Golden Hurricane were looking to avoid their fifth straight loss on the season. Tulsa trailed #23 USF 17-13 at HT but came back in the 2H before losing on a gw fg, 25-24.		
Nov. 7	at Navy	A					The Golden Hurricane have won B2B meetings against East Carolina after losing six straight. Tulsa would run for a series high 342 rushing yds in '18, tallying 616 total yds and win 45-24.		
Nov. 14	SMU	A					LTH ('18) Tulsa was on the 2nd of B2B away games and playing their road finale. The Golden Hurricane allowed a season high 389 (6.2) rushing yards in a game that determined last place in the West Division.		
Nov. 21	Tulane	A					The home team has won 8 of the L/9 meetings in the series. Tulsa has been an underdog three stryrs in this series but are 3-0 ATS in that span. LTH ('18) Tulsa held SMU to only 61 rushing yds in the 27-24 '18 win.		
Nov. 28	at Houston	A					'18 the Golden Hurricane were looking to avoid their seventh straight loss on the ssn and third straight loss to the Green Wave. Tulsa gave up 312 rush yds and a gw 39 yd rush td with 3:46 left to lose 24-17.		
							LTH ('18) both teams were off a bye and the game was played on a Thursday. Tulsa led 26-17 early fourth quarter before allowing 24 unanswered. Tulsa has lost three str in Houston.
