Oct. 3	Utah		G			CU is 2-7 vs Utes since joining the Pac-12 in '11. The Buffs have been an underdog all but once in the series and were most recently a 7.5 pt HD in '18. CU was held to only 196 yds and lost 30-7.
Oct. 10	at Arizona					LTH ('18) on a Friday CU was travelling for the third time in four weeks and off a stunning homecoming upset OT loss vs OSU. The Buffs led 10-0 after 1Q, but allowed 26 points in the 2Q and lost by eight.

Nov. 6	at Washington (Fri)		A			LTH ('18) CU was on the 2nd of back-to-back away games and UW was #15 AP. The Buffs were held to a season low 144 pass yards. CU trailed 14-13 at the half, but was held to 86 yards in the second half.
Nov. 14	UCLA		G			The home team has won the last five matchups in this series. Hasn't been upset in series since '02. Colorado tallied 477 yds and held the Bruins to 289 yds en route to 38-16 victory (-9') in '18.
Nov. 21	at Stanford		G			LTH ('16) CU was travelling for the fourth time in six weeks, entered off a blowout HC win, and had a bye on deck. The Buffs led 10-3 and took an intentional safety with :04 left.
