Louisiana was 4-1 vs non-conf foes LY. First meeting. The Ragin Cajuns are 1-20 all-time vs current Big 12 foes. Their only win came at home in 2009 over Kansas St 17-15.
 The Cajuns have won all four meetings against GST, however two of the four meetings have been decided by a fg or less. LTH '15 LA would only throw for 162 yds but they would get win, 23-21.
 Louisiana holds a slight 2-1 edge in the series over the Eagles. In the series the Cajuns have avg'd an impressive 216 rushing ypg. '17 LA surrendered 389 rush yards and lost by 10, 34-24.
Bonus: Louisiana was 3-1 ATS in 2019 as an away favorite.
Bonus: The road team in the Louisiana/ULM game is 18-2-1 ATS the last 21 years.
 These teams have met four times in the last two years including twice in the Sun Belt title game. LA is 0-8 against App St. LTH for reg ssn was '18. LA was a 25.5 pt road 'dog but only lost 27-17.
 Only the third meeting and the series is tied 1-1. '18 meeting was LA's conf opener against CCU. The Cajuns went into the half trailing 16-7. LA would give up 311 rushing yards and lose 30-28.
 LTH Louisiana was in midst of 1-10 season in 2000. Ragin Cajuns were crushed 47-2. Cajuns are 7-3 ATS in non-conf play and 5-1-1 as an away underdog under HC Napier.
 Louisiana is a perfect 7-0 against the Bobcats and are also a perfect 7-0 ATS! LTH ('18) LA was only a 3 point road 'dog. The Cajuns racked up 557 yards incl 327 rush yards and won 42-27.
 LA has won 5 of the L7 meetings against the Red Wolves. The Cajuns were off the loss at App St in '18 and back home. LA would erupt for 547 total yards and earn a big 47-43 upset victory.
 The Cajuns are looking for their fifth straight victory against the Jaguars, however all four of the wins are by 10 pts or less. The Cajuns would allow 477 yards on defense but would win by 10, 48-38.
 Louisiana only leads this series 30-25 against their in-state rivals, but have won 7 straight here (last road loss 13-10 in 2004). LTH the Cajuns were a 2.5 AD but pulled off the 31-28 upset.
