Oct. 3	at USC	A					LTH ('18) Cal entered off an upset blowout HC loss & was travelling for the 2nd time in three weeks, while OSU was off a bye. Patrick Laird ran for 193 yards and the Bears finished with a 539-241 yard edge.		
Oct. 10	Washington	A					LTH ('18) Cal entered off an emotional loss at #10 Wazzou, was on the 2nd of B2B away gms, & travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks. Cal was held to a ssn low 207 yds, but scored the GW td w/6:13 left.		
Oct. 17	at Washington St	A					The Bears have won the last two meetings after only winning one prior matchup from '09-'17. Cal was DD home 'dog (+11') in '18 and only had 242 yds but defense held strong to win 12-10.		
Oct. 24	<small>STANFORD IS OFF BYE</small> Stanford	A					LTH ('18) Cal entered off their home upset win over #15 UW and was travelling for the second time in three weeks. Wazzou was #10 AP. The Bears allowed the game-winning touchdown w/32 left.		
Oct. 31							These two academic powers first met in the Big Game in 1892! LY Cal snapped a nine yr losing skid to the Cardinal. '18 gm resked due to Cal wildfires. UC had yds and fd advantage but lost 23-13.		
Nov. 7	Oregon	A					<b>Bonus:</b> Cal has won 10 of their last 14 road openers. Cal is 2-3-1 as a road favorite the last five years. <b>Bonus:</b> Cal has won 16 of their L/18 home openers (last loss '13).		
Nov. 14	at Arizona	A					Last victory against the Ducks was here in '16 as a slight home favorite (-1'). Neither tm was ranked for first time in series since '11. Gm went 2OT before 28-yd gw fg to give Bears 52-49 win.		
Nov. 21	Utah	A					LTH Cal was handed their 14th consecutive P12 road loss. The Bears finished w/a +209 yd edge, led 14-10 at half and forced 5 TO's but threw a pick 6 with 3:13 left and the 'Cats won 24-17.		
Nov. 28	at Arizona St	A					The home team has won seven straight in this series dating back to 2000! The Bears have lost 3 of the L/4 mtgs. '16 Cal was back in Berkeley after a loss to ASU and edged #18 Utes 28-23.		
Dec. 4	UCLA (Fri)	A					LTH ('16) was the P12 opener for each. Cal entered off an upset home win over #11 TX & was travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks. The Bears led 24-10 HT. Tied at 34, Cal was outscored 17-7 in the L/3:17.		
Dec. 12							Cal was a td favorite in '18 against the Bruins and had lost B2B gms to Oregon and at Arizona. Normally stout Bears defense was gouged for 207 rush yds and Cal was blown out 37-7.
