Sep. 26	at Oklahoma	G					KSU has won 28 of their last 29 home openers. The Wildcats are 2-0 all-time vs Arkansas St but haven't met since 1980. KSU is 9-1 all-time against current Sun Belt foes.		
Oct. 3	Texas Tech	A					LTH ('18) KSU entered fresh off a bye. The 'Cats were held to a season low 13 first downs and allowed a season high 702 yards. The 37 point setback was the largest margin since 2015.		
Oct. 10	at TCU	G					In L9 meetings the 'Cats are 8-1 SU. During current 4-gm win streak KSU has given up an avg of 453 ypg to Texas Tech. '18 KSU held Red Raiders to 31 yds rushing on 26 attempts in 21-6 win.		
Oct. 17							LTH ('18) KSU was on the 2nd of B2B away games. 'Cats QB Skyler Thompson was injured in the 1Q as KSU also had a missed PAT, mishandled a fg snap, and muffed a punt in the 1 pt loss.		
Oct. 24	at Kansas	G					KSU has dominated their in-state rivals since '09 going a 11-0 SU and 8-3 ATS. KSU was on a 7-0 ATS run from '09-'15. The 'Cats trailed 3-0 in '18 and only had 59 yds at HT but rallied to win 21-17.		
Oct. 31	at West Virginia	A					KSU has dominated their in-state rivals since '09 going a 11-0 SU and 8-3 ATS. KSU was on a 7-0 ATS run from '09-'15. The 'Cats trailed 3-0 in '18 and only had 59 yds at HT but rallied to win 21-17.		
Nov. 7	Oklahoma St	A					LTH ('18) was KSU's B12 and road opener. WV was ranked #12 and the 'Cats 29 point loss was their largest away from home loss since falling by 52 points at Texas Tech in 2009.		
Nov. 14							Kansas St has won 6 of the L/8 in Manhattan against OSU. The Wildcats run game exploded in '18 matchup, rushing for 291 yds and defense held Pokes passing attack to 184 yds in 31-12 win.		
Nov. 21	at Iowa St	G					<b>Bonus:</b> Kansas St was 6-2 as an underdog LY and 9-4 ATS overall. <b>Oklahoma:</b> LY 48-41 upset was KSU biggest upset over the Sooners since '03 B12 Title gm.		
Nov. 28	at Baylor	A					LTH ('18) was the regular season finale, KSU needed a win to become bowl eligible, and ISU was ranked #25. The 'Cats led by 17 pts in the 4Q, but lost for the first time in 10 meetings.		
Dec. 5	Texas	A					LTH ('18) KSU had a halftime lead of 14-12 despite being outgained 313-158. There were three ties in the second half and the 'Cats allowed the GW 29 yard fg with :08 left.		
							The 'Cats last defeated Texas in '16 here in Manhattan 24-21 (E). Kansas St has lost three straight since then with all three losses coming by 6 points or less. '18 KSU only had 217 yds.
