Oct. 3	Mississippi	A					The Cats broke a 15 game series losing streak LTH in '09. KY was nearly 2 TD dogs. Aub got a blk'd FG TD in 1Q & led 14-7 at half. KY scored go ahead TD w/11:43 left. 'Cats are on 3-2 ATS run against the Tigers.		
Oct. 10	Mississippi St	G					Ole Miss leads series 27-14-1. Teams have split last 4 meetings. Home team has won 4 of the last 5 (3-2 ATS). HC Stoops is 3-9 SU/3-8-1 ATS vs SEC West foes.		
Oct. 17	at Tennessee	G					The home tm has won 5 str. Kentucky is just 2-9 s/'09 in this series. In '18 Kentucky was a 9.5 point home dog against Miss St. 'Cats held Bulldogs to series low 201 total yards and ran for 229 in 28-7 upset win.		
Oct. 24	Georgia	G					Visitor has lost 3 of L4. KY is 0-17 in Knoxville w/their L/win coming in 1984! LTH ('18) 'Cats were #12, but Vols pulled upset, holding UK to 262 yds incl just 77 rush. Vols led 17-0 at half thanks to Hail Mary on final play.		
Oct. 31	at Missouri	A					KY has lost 10 str in this series and 6 straight in Lexington. The 'Cats were ranked #11 in heading into their '18 matchup at Kroger Field against the 'Dawgs but would lose 34-17 while surrendering 331 rush yds.		
Nov. 7							MO won F/3 SEC mtgs, but Kentucky has now won 5 straight. LTH ('18) KY trailed 14-3 at half. They got 67 yd PR td in 3Q. Down 14-9, 'Cats drove 81/8pl & TE Conrad caught GW td pass on final play.		
Nov. 14	Vanderbilt	G					Bonus: Kentucky hasn't won their final SEC home game since 2011 (0-8). Bonus: Wildcats have lost 8 of their last 9 SEC road finales.		
Nov. 21	at Alabama	G					Home tm is 7-3. KY has won 4 straight in the series and the last 3 when hosting Vandy. Only 1 upset in last 11 mtgs. In '18 'Cats only threw 9 times against the 'Dores but ran for 280 in 14-7 win.		
Nov. 28	at Florida	A					LTH in '16 Kentucky lost to #1 Bama 34-6 but did cover the 5 td spread. The 'Cats are 0-21-1 all-time on the road vs the Crimson Tide. The visitor has covered 6 straight in this series.		
Dec. 5	South Carolina	G					After 2 near misses in '16 and '17, KY finally ended their 31 year losing streak to Florida with a 27-16 win '18. The 'Cats led 21-16 and added a defensive TD on gms final play for deceiving final.		
							Kentucky has lost 6 of L/9. After losing 5 straight, the 'Cats have won 3 of L/4 incl LTH ('18) 56-10 with a 601-305 yd edge. Kentucky holds a narrow 17-15 all-time edge in the series against their in-state rival.
