Oct. 3	at Washington St	A					LTH ('15) Oregon was off an upset blowout home loss while it was Colorado's P12 opener. It was tied at HT, but the Ducks all'd ssn lows in rush (77) and total (308) yards and won by over two touchdowns.		
Oct. 9	Arizona St (Fri)	A					LTH ('18) was a Top 25 matchup. Oregon entered off an OT upset over #7 Washington, while Wazzou was off a bye. The Ducks trailed 27-0 at the half and were held to a regular season low 58 rush yards.		
Oct. 17	at Oregon St						Oregon will be playing with vengeance after LY's 31-28 upset loss in Tempe that cost Ducks shot at CFP. Ducks narrowly escaped the Sun Devils in '18. Held 28-13 lead in 3Q but only won 31-29.		
Oct. 24							LTH ('18) on a Fri, neither was ranked for the 3rd str yr. The Ducks were travelling for the 4th time in 6 wks, while the Beavers were home for the 2nd time in 5 wks. Oregon finished w/a ssn high 392 rush yds.		
Oct. 31	Washington	A					<b>Bonus:</b> Oregon has won 15 straight home openers & has scored 40+ in 14 of them (38 pts in '09). <b>Bonus:</b> Oregon is 4-11 ATS as an underdog vs Pac 12 opponents the last 4 seasons.		
Nov. 7	at California <small>CALIFORNIA IS OFF BYE</small>	A					Ducks rebounded from '16 70-21 blowout loss at Autzen to the Huskies with 30-27 OT win in '18. Teams exchanged scores in 3Q and entered OT tied at 24. RB Verdell gw td for upset victory.		
Nov. 14	USC	A					LTH ('18) was a Top 25 matchup. Oregon was in their road opener & Cal was off a bye & in their P12 opener. The Ducks led 28-10 HT & finished with 485 yards, the most the Bears allowed all season.		
Nov. 20	at Arizona (Fri)	A					Oregon last hosted the Trojans here in '15. Ducks were ranked #23 while USC was #22. Led by Heisman winning QB Mariota Oregon put up 578 yds of total offense and went on to win 48-28.		
Nov. 28	Stanford	A					LTH ('18) Oregon was #19 AP, on the 2nd of B2B away gms, & Arizona was their 1st non-ranked foe in 5 gms. The Ducks were held to a reg ssn low 270 yards and lost by 29 points as nearly a DD favorite.		
Dec. 5	at Utah	A					Oregon last defeated the Cardinal here in '14, 45-16 (-7). LTH ('18) the Ducks led 24-7 at half with a 304-135 yd edge. In 2H and OT Oregon was outscored 31-7 and were stunned in 38-31 loss.		
Dec. 12							LTH in '18, Utah was w/o QB Huntley and RB Moss. The Utes got 174 rush yds from RB Shyne and led 19-7 at half. UO led 25-22 4Q then Utah scored the games last 10 pts to win 32-25.
