Oct. 3	at Arizona St	G					LTH ('18) Stanford entered off a Top 25 matchup loss vs Wazzou. UW was home for the 2nd time in 5 wks w/a bye on deck. Stanford trailed 21-0 HT, cut it to 27-23, but was int'd at the GL on the final pl.		
Oct. 10	USC	G					LTH on a Thursday, Stanford was off B2B losses. The Cardinal were outgained 437-358 but finished +4 TO's and won 20-13. SU led just 6-3 at half and 20-6 4Q.		
Oct. 17							Cardinal have lost 3 of last 4 meetings against USC but won on The Farm in '18. The Stanford defense pressured USC freshman QB Daniels and held USC to only three points, won 17-3 (-5).

Oct. 30	<small>WASHINGTON ST IS OFF BYE</small> Washington St (Fri)	G					LTH ('18) was the reg ssn finale ply'd 2 wks later than originally scheduled (wildfires). Both had 7+ wins for just the 2nd time over the prior 27 mtgs. The Cardinal led 23-6 and allowed a garbage td w/ 10 left.		
Nov. 7	<small>UCLA IS OFF BYE</small> at UCLA	G					After winning eight in a row from '08-'15 the Cougars have taken the last four in the series. In the last five meetings Stanford is 0-5 ATS and have given up an average of 490.2 ypg.		
Nov. 14	Oregon St	G					LTH ('18) on Sr Day Stanford entered off an unscheduled bye following the postponement of their trip to Cal. The Cardinal led 27-20 at the half, trailed 42-41 4Q, and scored the GW td with 8:19 left.		
Nov. 21	Colorado	G					Cardinal have dominated L/10 yrs of this series, winning all ten games and posting a 6-2-2 ATS mark! Stanford was a 24 point favorite on The Farm in '18 and posted a series high 596 yds to win 48-17.		
Nov. 28	at Oregon	A					Since the Buffs joined the Pac-12 in '11 Stanford holds a slim 3-2 margin in the series winning the first 3 mtgs but dropping the L/2. '16 Cardinal were held to 263 yds and 15 fd in 10-5 low scoring loss.		
Dec. 5	Arizona	G					LTH ('18) was a Top 20 matchup. Stanford was in their road opener and Oregon was playing their P12 opener. The Cardinal trailed 24-7 at the half, rallied to tie on the final play of regulation, and won in OT.
