Florida St HC Mike Norvell is on the hottest of seats and needs a big year. Last year he opened strong at 3-0 beating two non P4 teams by 74 and 56. Tony Sanchez is 22-17 ATS as an AD. Ashton Daniels takes over at QB for FSU and they added 103 starts via the portal and lost 98. They are #61 on my Experience Chart. Tony Sanchez is in year three and has his beat team and a new attitude as the Aggies have a new Game Field, Scoreboard, Locker room and Practice Field. They have 3 QB's he feels good about. My computer has FSU 41-10. The Seminoles do have a huge Monday Night home game on deck vs SMU! Your best play in this one may be Florida St in the first half as they figure to come out charged up like last year but with that huge game on deck may let up late. I will go with my computers number here and it is right at the Vegas number.

Phil's Forecast:

Sacramento St played in FCS, Big Sky conf from 1996-'25. EM is 2-1 vs Big Sky (last in 1974). Since '16, EMU is 8-2 in openers (lost at TxSt LY) & 6-4 ATS. Hornets first conf game as a MAC member & first in FB5. Sacramento St is 3-2 SU but just 1-4 ATS in road openers. Hornets just 1-6 SU but 6-1 ATS at FBS teams since '18. Sac St was not expecting to move up to FBS and have a FCS roster playing in the FB5. Eastern Michigan is usually one of the least experienced teams in the MAC but is #1 this year on my Exp Chart in the MAC and #7 in the FB5 overall (they were #111 in '25). QB Noah Kim three for 2817 yards (61%, 19-11) and is back plus they add in Brayden Bennett at RB (781, 58 CCar '24). Bryce Llewellyn had 102 tackles last year and leads an improved defense. Eastern is my #7 Most Improved team. Sac St is led by Carson Conklin at QB who threw for 2878 (62%) in '24 here then transferred to Fresno last year and returns. The Hornets are just #116 on my Exp Chart. My computer has this Eastern 39-17. Chris Creighton is 12-21 ATS as a HF and Sac St is 18-9-1 ATS as an AD so the angles side with Sac but Eastern is the most experienced they have ever been under Creighton and off a pair of losing seasons and Sac St's spread numbers were in FCS competition vs West Coast teams. First trip East for Sac St. and first ever on GRAY turf. My computer has this as a Best Bet.

Last time here in '23, Spartans (+31) lost 56-28 but covered on a TD with 5:08 left. First game vs B1G since '14. Since '19, San Jose 5-2 SU/ATS in openers. Last 2 times Trojans opened season vs Spartans, they won 30-7 in '21 & 56-28 in '23. USC 39-1-1 all-time vs MWC. Under HC Riley, USC 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS in openers. San Jose had a disappointing year last year and are rebuilt this year as they lose QB Walker Eget to Duke and WR Danny Scudero to Colorado and have just 2 starters back overall. Luke Weaver a Hawaii transfer is at QB and I had low expectations for the Spartans in Niumatalolo's first year but he surprised me an made a bowl and San Jose is 8-3 ATS as an AD. USC looks like a playoff contender this year and under Riley have beaten their G6 foes by 44 ppg. Riley told me it is his best defense since he has been there, and new DC Gary Patterson was a great pickup. QB Jayden Maiava has my #5 rated offensive line in front of him and a dangerous set of RB's. My computer has it 54-7 and they could be covering the spread by half and only have Fresno and Louisiana on deck. I may use this one on the Phil Steele Tour with Selections which I will be putting up on Wednesday this week.

Rebels 4-0 SU & 3-1 ATS (beat Idaho St LY, 38-31, as 31pt fav) vs non conference under Mullen. First of two games vs The American. Last 4 years, UNLV 14-6 SU & 16-4 ATS vs non-conf! Memphis has a new HC and just one returning starter from last year. They have two VHT QB's in Marcus Stokes and Air Noland (PS#5 Ohio St) and lots of NIL money but it will take time with 71 new players overall and a first year head coach. UNLV HC Dan Mullen enters year two and has 3 starters back on both offense and defense from last year. I expect a big year from Jackson Arnold at QB (PS#5) to have a big year if he beats out Alex Orji (PS#31, Michigan). Jet Thomas is back at RB and this is year two for HC Mulleand they are the favorites to win the new Mountain West. Charles Huff is 8-5 ATS as an AD and Mullen is 1-4 ATS as a HF with UNLV. My computer has this UNLV 30-27 but I think the Rebels are better poised to start the season off strong and the Rebels are laying just 5' and get the cover at home in Raiders stadium in the late game starting at 10:00 ET.

Phil's Forecast:

NC St has won 4 straight 16 of last 7 in series to take 38-22-1 series lead (5-2 ATS). Last year Cavs (+3) lost on road, 35-31, despite +98 yds. UVA 8-2 SU/6-4 ATS last 10 openers. This game was originally schedule for Brazil but now is a home game for Virginia. Virginia was in the ACC title game last year and is breaking in a new QB but has the most experienced team in the ACC. The D has basically 8 starters back (including transfers) and they added 149 portal starts. Virginia was 6-2 at home last year their first winning records at home in 4 years. Beau Pribila is the new QB and started for Missouri last year. NCST is just 8-17-1 ATS as an AD but does have CJ Bailey back and a dream schedule. The Wolfpack have the talent and the schedule to be like Virginia was last year (a surprise) and could finally get to that double digit win barrier that HC Dave Doeren has been trying to break thru. The defense was a problem last year but Doeren feels that in the 2nd year of DJ Eliot's D they will be much improved. NCST has won their last 3 trips here outright including a pair of upsets. My computer has it Virginia 26-22, but I will take a shot with the underdog winning outright. Eight of the last 15 meetings were outright upsets (5 NCST/3 UVA). I like the fact that North Carolina St is getting over a FG in what I consider a toss-up game.
